

Designs to Quilt Using the

Arabesque Ogee 6x4 Template Set


Like the smaller ogee, the Arabesque Ogee 6x4 template(s) can be used to create similar patterns, just slightly larger in scale. These include a "mesh", illustrated below on the left without the inner echo. Mark vertical lines spaced 4" apart, along with a starting line (blue) and markers vertically every 6". This template can be used to create attractive mandalas too, three of which are shown on the right. Simple marking lines (red) assist in orienting the ogee shapes appropriately.




The larger ogee template set can be used to create frames. The ones illustrated require either a fully marked 6"x6" square, or at the lest, marking of where the corners of the square are located (blue dots). Both orientations fill a 10" x10" space but can be easily enlarged by using a larger marked square and adding straight quilting on both edges of the ogee shape. If enlarging, take care to mark the center of the pattern so that the ogee curves center appropriately.



Many of the designs shown for the Ogee 4x4 can be also quilted using the Ogee 6x4 templates too.
