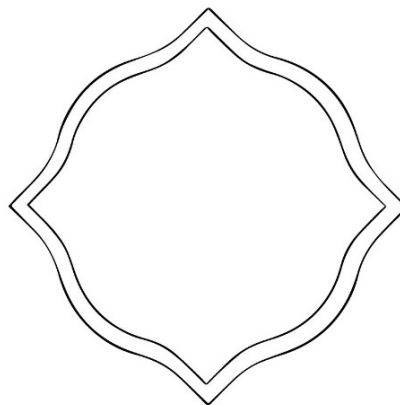
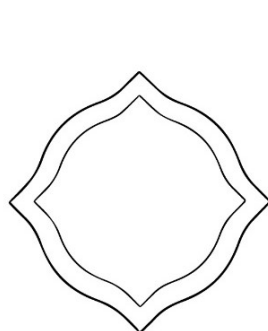
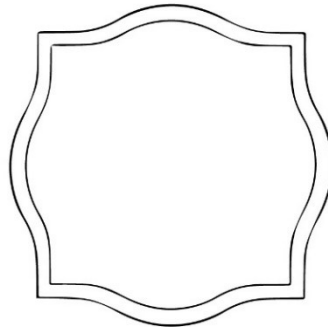
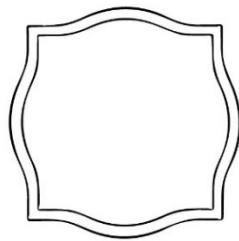
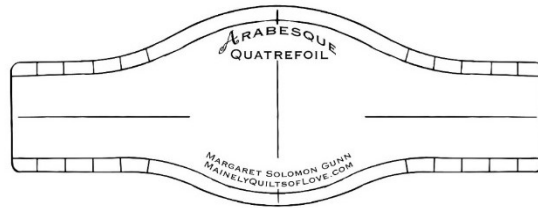
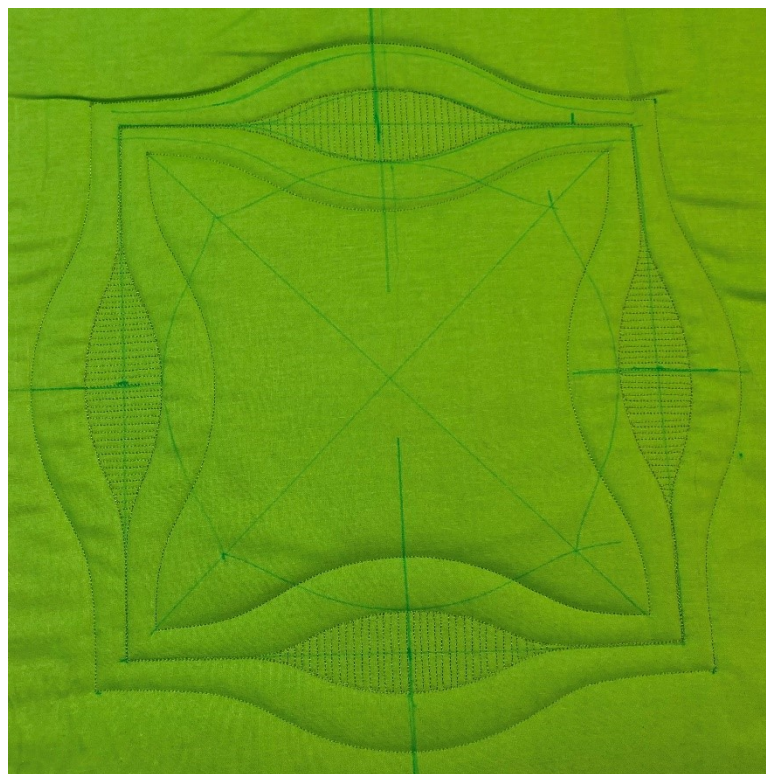
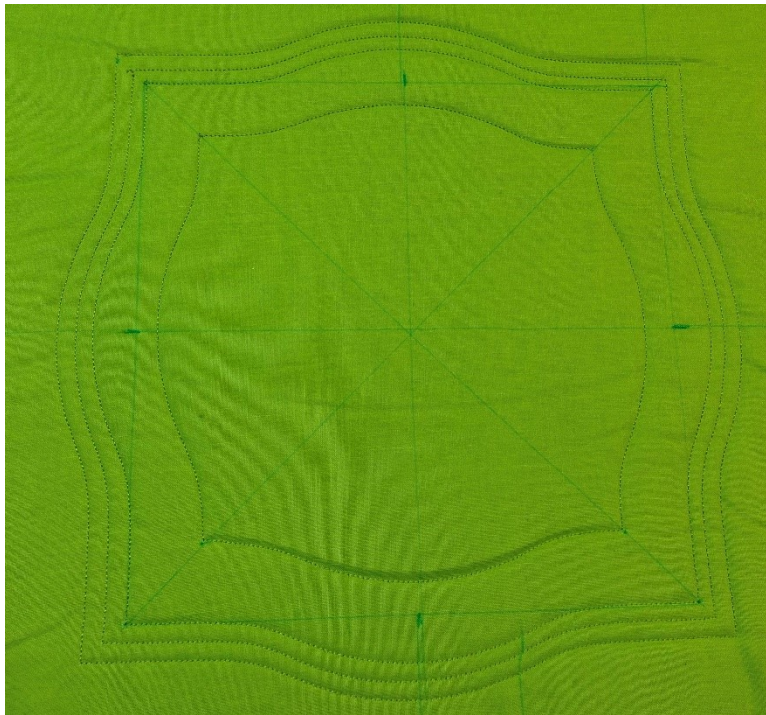


Arabesque Quatrefoil Template

A quatrefoil is a design that appears to have four rounded lobes, as though a circle has been superimposed onto a square. The Arabesque Quatrefoil template allows stitching designs that seamlessly transition a curved element to a linear edge, without using two arc templates. This template eliminates the undesired inflection point which can be challenging to stitch smoothly. The template has two different sizes of quatrefoil shape available, one on each side of the template, labeled A and B. The upper curve creates frames between ~9" and 12", while the lower curve makes frames between ~7" and 11". Block frames can be easily enlarged by quilting additional straight length along the edges. The quatrefoil template has curves etched $\frac{1}{4}$ " inboard of both edges to create up to $\frac{1}{2}$ " echo lines.

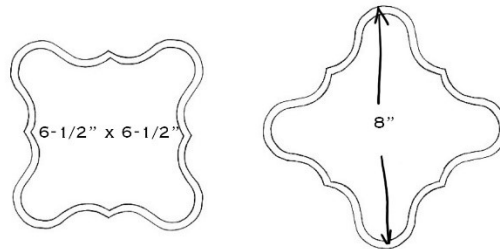




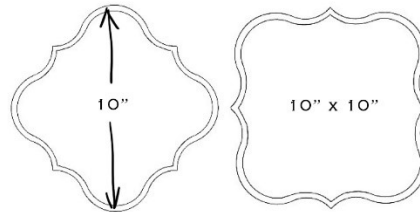

Comparison of Frame Size of all Templates

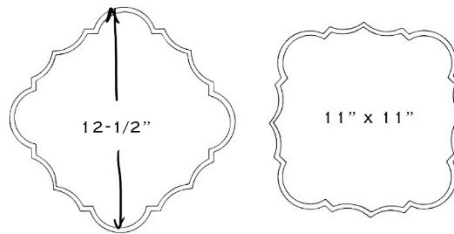

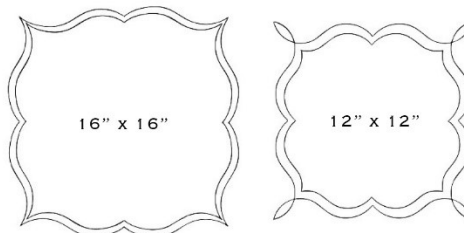

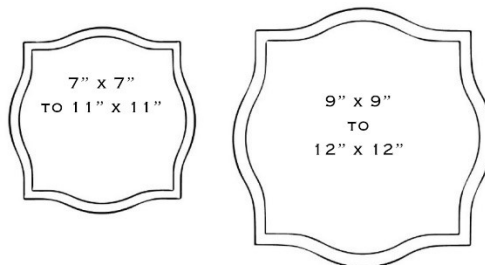
